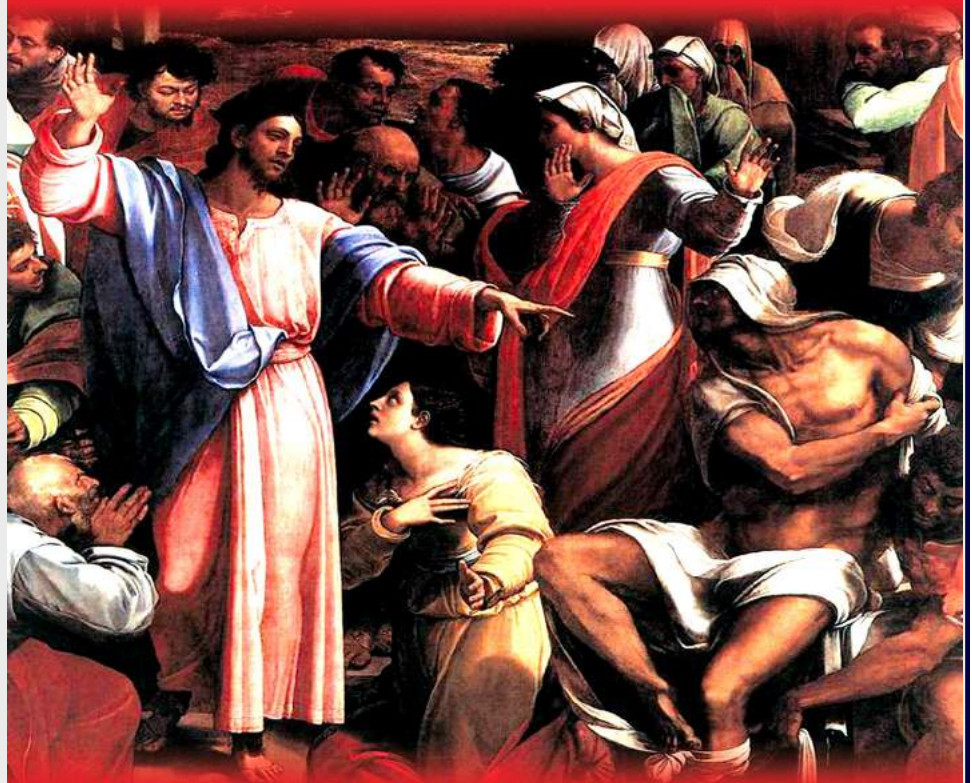

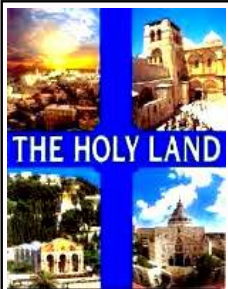

To commemorate these events, the Society in the United States celebrates the last Sunday of April as Ozanam Sunday.”

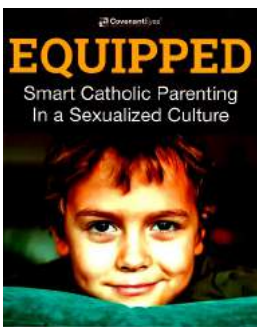

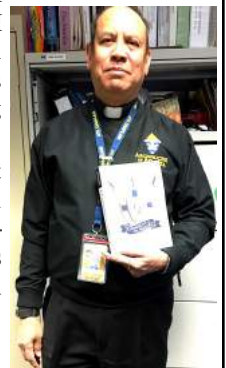

WHAT WE’RE READING: Deacon Peter Swan, *Champions of the Rosary*

Growing up Catholic, we always said the rosary but did not truly know the history of it or what a role it played in the Salvation of Souls until recently when a priest at the airport handed me a copy of *Champions of the Rosary* by Donald H. Calloway, MIC. At first, I took the book home and put it with the rest of the “To Read Later” pile in my library. Then one day, while saying the rosary I looked at the beads in my hand and wondered what was behind this great Spiritual Weapon that had and continue to play such a major role, not only in the Catholic Church but in the Salvation of the world. Then, I remembered the book the priest has given me and began, at first, to just flip through the pages. But then, a few words like “Spiritual Sword” and “Converting Souls” piqued my interest.

Champions of the Rosary, is probably the most comprehensive book I have ever read on the rosary. The book talks about how the rosary first came to be, and how it was loved by some and hated by others. How some were devoted to it, promoted it and how some tried to get rid of it. It tells of the story of the rosary, weaving the historical, theological, and devotional aspects of what for some has become one of the signs of being a Catholic. It also explains why some religious orders, such as the Franciscans and the Trappist carry the rosary on their belts. **This book should turn every one of its readers into a champion of the rosary and in this age and world of turmoil, we all should (once again) turn to the Blessed Mother and her wonderful and spiritual gift of the Holy Rosary!** It is available on Amazon for about \$17.00.

A MESSAGE FROM DARLEINE ARCE, OUR CATECHETICAL COORDINATOR



During the Lenten season, I think it is important to remember the special love that St. Francis of Assisi had for the Passion of Christ, so much so, that he received the gift of stigmata (wounds of Christ) to share in Christ’s own suffering. Early pilgrims were able to visit the original sites in the Holy Land to walk the way of the cross, which was (& still is) under the custody of Franciscans. However, much like today, not all the faithful have the resources to undertake such a trip, so, in the early 17th century, Pope Innocent XI granted permission for Franciscans to erect [14] stations within their churches to remember these sacred places on Jesus’ way to Calvary. Over time, restrictions were lifted and they gave permissions to both non-Franciscan parishes and Bishops to have Stations of the Cross and to erect the stations.

This is a special devotion to me, so much so, that I thoroughly enjoy and relish in praying the St. Alphonsus Liguori version (because it intimately describes Christ’s suffering and allows me to bear the weight, so to speak, of my personal sins.) Through penitential practices (fasting, almsgiving, and prayer) participating in Stations of the Cross allows me to unite my suffering to that of Christ on the “way of suffering” (*via dolorosa*) and to make reparations for the offenses that have been committed against the body of Christ. I hope you will join me sometime before our Lenten observance concludes!

Please be respectful of fellow parishioners and visitors. **There are many parking spaces in lots on the side and rear of the Church.** It is not necessary to park along the curb in front of, on the side of, or the back of the Church. **The San Damiano parking lot is reserved for Seniors and those with handicap parking permits.** All other handicapped parking spots should be reserved for those with permits, including the ones behind the church. Also, observe the areas marked "NO PARKING" in front of the parish hall and white garage as well as other curbside areas around the property. **These areas must be kept clear for emergency vehicles and access to the garage.** Parking problems should not mar our observance of this holy season—think, "What would Jesus do?"

Estas áreas deben estar libres para vehículos de emergencia y acceso al garaje. Problemas de estacionamiento no deben estropear nuestra observancia de esta santa temporada---piensen: '¿Qué haría Jesús?'
