

P A R K I N G I N S T R U C T I O N S F O R E A S T E R S U N D A Y

- The front, upper entrance to the parish campus (closer to the church and Founders' Hall) is ENTRANCE ONLY (no exit).
 - RIGHT SIDE= DROP OFF
 - LEFT SIDE= THRU PARKING
- The lower entrance to the parish (traffic light- Roberts rd.) is EXIT ONLY (no entrance).
 - RIGHT LANE= RIGHT TURN
 - LEFT LANE= LEFT TURN
- The handicap spots directly in front of the entrance will be closed to allow more drop off space. The spots directly in front of the garden will be used for wheelchair access.
- The San Damiano parking area is for other handicap purposes.
- The spots just outside of the San Damiano parking area will be closed off to assist in traffic flow.
- There will be dedicated golf carts to transport people from the San Damiano parking area to the entrance.
- **There will be no pickup at the front entrance after mass.** However, there will be a dedicated golf cart to transport people from the entrance to the San Damiano parking area.
- The Knights of Columbus parking lot will be open for additional parking only.
- There will be no entrance to the campus from the Knights parking lot; please use the golf carts.
- There will be police officers at the entrances /exits to the campus to help facilitate traffic/parking.
- There will be parking attendants to help facilitate parking throughout the campus.
- There will be golf carts to transport people to/from the parking lots and the church.
 - There will be designated golf cart pick-up/drop-off points. If you wish to utilize golf cart transport, please wait at these designated areas.
- **Park only in designated spaces unless you are explicitly told to do so.**
- **There is ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING:**
 - Along curbs;
 - In fire lanes;
 - In front of Founders' Hall;
 - At the friary OR on the grass unless otherwise noted.
- Observe the legal aspects of parking, which include parking or not parking in handicapped spaces. Handicapped parking spaces are clearly marked with signs and/or special striping, and are wider than regular spaces to accommodate wheel chairs. They are located near disabled ramps, very close to building entrances. If you DO NOT require the use of these spaces, and do not have a permit, park somewhere else, or else risk your vehicle being towed.
- Be aware of your surroundings, and considerate of others.
 - Do not speed or deliberately block other cars, or lanes of traffic.
